





Educational Attainment




HEALTH = INCOME




ACROSS ALL RACIAL/ETHNIC GROUPS

Family Income




PERCENT OF PERSONS WITH POOR/FAIR HEALTH*

...BUT POVERTY IS CONCENTRATED








