K - 8 Achievement

<u>Spartanburg</u>: Cleveland Academy of Leadership achieved the **highest growth rating in their district**, a growth rating that was amongst the **top 15% of schools in the state**.

<u>Indianapolis</u>: Avondale Meadows Academy is one of the **top ten elementary schools in the district**.

Atlanta: Drew Charter School outperformed the district and state on all state standardized assessments with an average margin of difference of 15 percentage points.







Community Wellness





Network Members continue to invest in programs and facilities that support families and help to bring communities together.
