About Us

In 2015, four organizations (KIPP Texas, St. Luke's United Methodist Church, Legacy Community Health and the YMCA of Greater Houston) came together, under the Purpose Built Communities Model, to more efficiently leverage their strengths and assets to support the students and families in Gulfton/Sharpstown. By aligning their missions and sharing resources, they knew they could dramatically increase their impact in the neighborhood. In 2016, the four partners helped establish Connect Community, a single purpose nonprofit 'Community Quarterback' which provides a strong, visionary leadership team capable of bringing diverse entities together to ensure that partners and residents have their North Star pointed toward aligned neighborhood outcomes.
